Forum materials are printed without editing - from the provided originals.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse to print unedited materials that do not meet the topic or requirements or that are sent after the specified deadline.

The materials are submitted in the electronic version of the file in Word format for Windows XP (the file must have the extension .rtf), 3-4 full pages of A5 format (148×210 mm); Times New Roman font, size 10, single line spacing; margins should be: right, left, top, bottom - 20 mm.

All drawings contained in the materials are made in graphic editors compatible with the text editor Word.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse to print unedited materials that do not meet the topic or requirements or that are sent after the specified deadline.

Formulas are executed in the Microsoft Equation formula editor. Formula style for Microsoft Equation.

The size of the components of the formula:

Full _____ 10 pt.

Subscript/Superscript _____ 9 pt.

Sub-Subscript/Superscript _____ 7 pt.

Symbol _____ 13 pt.

Syb-Symbol _____ 9 pt.

Formulas should be separated from the text by one line, centered. If there is a reference to them in the text, they should be numbered. Formula numbers must be right-justified. The numbers are indicated in round brackets.

Each illustration, diagram, diagram must be signed, and the table must have a title. Illustrations and tables are numbered with Arabic numerals

through numbering. Tables and illustrations are placed below the text in which they are referenced. Illustrations should be black and white, clear and contrasting, without a background. It is not possible to make color graphics.

The name of the figure and explanatory data are placed under the illustration and centered. *For example:*

Fig. 1. Device details (9 pt bold).

Each figure should be separated by one line spacing above and below the main text. Drawings must be made in Word 2003.

Each table should be separated by one line spacing above and below the main text. Above the table, its serial number (Table 1) should be placed, aligned on the right edge, under which place the name of the table, aligned in the center. *Example:*

The initials and surnames of the author(s) should be highlighted in bold; Full name of the author(s), scientific degree, scientific title - bright; the name of the higher institution, the city - in brackets in light italics. Align everything to the left margin of the page; the name of theses - in large, bold letters in the center; after indenting the line, print the text of theses; single line spacing. Type theses text without hyphens.

A list of used sources (References) should not be submitted in theses.

For example:

O.M. Ivanov, Dr. Tech. Sciences, prof. (*NUFT, Kyiv*)
A.A. Petrov, candidate Tech. Sciences, associated prof. (*SBTU, Kharkiv*)
