AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION

§ 1

State Biotechnology University (Kharkiv, Ukraine) and Turan University (Almaty, Kazakhstan), hereinafter referred to as the "Parties", declare co-operation in undertaking scientific research, education and developing academic contacts (relations, bonds) between students, academics, and scientific workers from both institutions.

§ 2

Cooperation between the Parties shall be implemented by:

- a) conducting joint scientific research and didactic projects within the field of common interest;
- b) sharing best-practices in regard to teaching and teaching programmes;
- c) exchanging academics and scientific workers;
- d) exchanging students;
- e) joint participation in international scientific projects;
- f) joint organisation of symposia, seminars, and scientific conferences;
- g) exchanging scientific information, publications, didactic materials (including an exchange between library stocks of both institutions);
- h) development of double diploma programmes and other forms of co-operation established by both Parties.

The development and implementation of specific activities and projects based on this Memorandum of Cooperation will be discussed separately between the faculties, schools or institutes carrying out specific activities and projects. Before starting any such activity or project, a special agreement will be drawn up and signed by both parties, which will specify all the terms and conditions. Each party agrees to carry out certain activities and projects in accordance with the laws and regulations of their respective countries after full consultation and approval.

If joint research activities pursuant to this Memorandum result in any intellectual property potential, each party shall seek a fair and equitable settlement of ownership rights and other proprietary rights that may arise.

§ 3

1. Detailed conditions for carrying out undertakings within the framework of the co-operation can be regulated in annual or long-term programmes.
2. Details concerning the financing of all undertakings of this Agreement shall be agreed on separately, in a written agreement.
3. Implementation of this Agreement shall be in accordance with legal provisions applicable in both countries.

§ 4

1. This Agreement shall enter into force upon the date of signature and shall remain in force for 5 years. It can be renewed as annexes. Each Party can terminate this Agreement in writing. Such termination shall become effective 6 months after giving the notification.
2. This Agreement may be revised or extended by mutual agreement between the Parties.
3. This Agreement is drawn up in two copies, simultaneously in English, Ukrainian and Russian languages, which have equal legal force, one copy for each of the Parties.
