## REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts should be typed in the text editor Word for Windows (file with the extension .doc), volume - 1-3 full pages of A4 format; font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, single line spacing; all margins - 25 mm.

The title of the abstract should be typed in large bold letters in the centre, initials and surnames of the author(s) should be bold; full name of the author(s), (academic degree, academic title), name of the organization and country should be aligned to the right

edge of the page; indented a line, type the text of the abstract; line spacing - single. The text should be typed without hyphens.

Type formulas in the Microsoft Equation editor. Size of formula components: Full - 14 pt, Subscript/Superscript - 13 pt, Sub-Subscript/Superscript - 10 pt, Symbol - 18 pt, Syb-Symbol - 13 pt.

Formulas should be separated by one line from the text and centred. If they are referenced in the text, they should be numbered. Formula numbers should be aligned to the right. The numbers are indicated in parentheses.

Each illustration, diagram, scheme must be signed, and each table must have a title.

Illustrations and tables are numbered in Arabic numerals with a through numbering.

Tables and illustrations are placed below the text in which they are referenced.

Illustrations and graphs should be clear (font size may be reduced to 12 pt). Each figure is separated by a single line interval from the top and bottom of the main text.

All figures contained in the conference abstracts should be made in graphic editors compatible with the Word text editor. The title of the figure and explanatory data are placed below the illustration, and the alignment is in the centre. For example:

Figure 1 - Distribution of plantations...

Each table is separated by a single line interval at the top and bottom of the main text. Above the table, place its name, aligned to the width. For example:

Table 1 - Experimental results

References to information sources should be made in accordance with the APA (American Psychological Association) style. Do not use automatic numbering of lists.
