### **Content of Academic Seminars and Workshops**

We invite academic staff to participate in a focused series of seminars and workshops aimed at strengthening forest-based education in Ukraine through **dual education approaches** and **new didactic tools**.

**Target Participants:** 36 Ukrainian university staff members who will develop study courses within the ForestPost project.

#### **Participation Requirements:**

- Affiliation with Ukrainian National Forestry University (UNFU), National University of Life and Environmental Science (NUBIP), State Biotechnological University (SBTU).
- English language proficiency (working level – minimum B1 recommended).
- Relevance of academic/professional background to forestry or related disciplines.
- Motivation.



## **Submission Procedure**

Applicants are required to submit a single PDF document containing:

- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Motivation letter (max 1 page) explaining your interest and how the seminar aligns with your current teaching, research, or institutional responsibilities.
- Proof of English proficiency (if available).

## **Selection Process**

All applications will be evaluated by the Selection Committee based on the following criteria:

- Relevance of academic/professional background to forestry or related disciplines.
- Motivation for participation.
- English proficiency.
- Obligation and capacity to develop study courses within the project.

Based on this evaluation, the Committee will formulate a ranking list of applicants, where 1 = highest priority and n = lowest priority (corresponding to the total number of applications received).

Selected participants will be notified individually via email.

## **Financial Conditions:**

Travel costs, accommodation, and subsistence will be covered by the sending institution through the ForestPost grant. Participants have to coordinate funding arrangements with their home institutions (UNFU, NUBIP, SBTU respectively).
