

GENER	AL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT (DISCIPLINE)
Goal	Bioethics and professional ethics are the science of morality as a set of norms and principles of human behavior in society. The main objective of the subject is to study the doctor's attitude towards himself, his work, colleagues, and society as a whole, methods of forming stable moral qualities of a specialist, and establishing the boundary between legal and moral behavior. "Professional Ethics with the Fundamentals of Bioethics" belongs to the cycle of disciplines that provide broadening of horizons, improvement and spiritual growth of the individual, the ability to carry out collective activities. The norms and principles of behavior of people in a team are based on ethics and morality, which have their own characteristics for people of different professions. and are determined by the specifics of their work. From this point of view, the issues of professional ethics of a veterinary medicine specialist deserve attention, who, in the process of performing his complex and multifaceted official duties, constantly communicates with people of different professions, managers of various ranks, livestock breeders, animal owners, and finally, with his colleagues and employees. That is, medical ethics interprets a system of norms and requirements for behavior, the moral character of a doctor, as well as moral feelings that are realized in in the process of work.
