#### Activities to be carried out:

A program will be created that will include the following:

Depending on the availability of the responsible institutions

- Acquaintance with the features of the organization of the educational process at TiHo and the training of applicants for educational programs in veterinary medicine.
- Discussion of potential opportunities for scientific cooperation between TiHo and the State Biotechnological University (SBU) in common scientific areas (veterinary epidemiology, modern diagnostics, treatment and prevention of animal diseases of various species, etc.).
- Discussion of academic mobility opportunities for teachers, scientists and applicants with the organization of short-term internships and exchange of experience, in particular, practical training of applicants of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of SBU within the framework of educational and industrial practices.
- Discussion of possibilities to assist a Ukrainian institution in bringing educational programs to EAEVE (European Association of Establishments for Veterinary Education) standards for further integration into the EU.
- Exchange of experience on the application of digital technologies in veterinary medicine (e-Health).
- Introduction to the work of TiHo's specialized clinics: Clinic for horses; Clinic for small domestic animals; Clinic for cattle; Clinic for pigs; Clinic for small ruminants; Clinic for birds, reptiles and amphibians; Center for Reproductive Medicine.
- Introduction to the work of research institutes at TiHo: Institute of Virology; Institute of Microbiology; Institute of Parasitology; Institute of Epidemiology;



Institute of Pathology; Institute of Pharmacology, Toxicology and Pharmacy; Institute of Meat Hygiene and Technology; Institute of Food Quality and Safety; Institute of Animal Hygiene and Animal Welfare; Institute of Animal Breeding Biology and Genetics; Institute of Animal Nutrition; Institute of Anatomy; Institute of Physiology and Physiological Chemistry; Institute of Zoology; Institute of Terrestrial and Aquatic Wildlife (ITAW).

- Introduction to the Clinical Skills Lab (CSL): a center for practical training for applicants using highly realistic simulators and mannequins.
- Introduction to the work of RIZ (Research Center for Emerging Infections and Zoonoses).
- Introduction to the work of IBEI (Institute of Biometrics and Information Processing) and methods of maintaining veterinary statistics, IT technologies and digital veterinary medicine.

The TiHo is a leading educational institution for veterinary medicine in Europe. The impressions and contacts contribute to the further development of professional expertise and the internationalization of the universities.
