to be held on **9 October 2026** as part of the Erasmus+ Jean Monnet Module project
"European Architecture of Sustainable Development: Economic and Financial Integration
Mechanisms" – SusDEFIM (No. 101127849).

Academic staff of higher education institutions, postgraduate and doctoral students, representatives of public authorities, professional and civil society organisations, and the business community are invited to participate in the conference.

The conference aims to consolidate and disseminate research experience in improving mechanisms for ensuring the sustainable development of the national economy amid contemporary challenges, drawing on international practices for addressing current social, environmental and economic problems.

Conference thematic areas:

1. Financial architecture for sustainable development, green finance and financial market innovation.
2. European economic and financial integration: international experience, strategic priorities and mechanisms for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.
3. Digital transformation of business processes, information and analytical technologies, and cybersecurity in the context of sustainable economic development.
4. Sustainable development of entrepreneurship, trade, logistics, tourism, and the hospitality and restaurant industry within the European economic area.
5. Contemporary management and marketing: innovative business models, market technologies, reputation management and customer experience.
6. Social, environmental, legal and educational foundations of sustainable development: human capital, professional competencies and social responsibility.

- ✓ Conference languages: Ukrainian, English and Polish.
- ✓ Participation in the conference is free of charge.
- ✓ The conference will be held online.

Technical requirements for abstract preparation

The abstract must be attached to the conference participant registration form as a Microsoft Word file (.doc or .docx). The file name must include the surname of the first author, for example: Karpov_Abstract.

The abstract must not exceed 3 full A4 pages. All page margins must be 2 cm.

Main text formatting: Times New Roman; 14 pt; single line spacing (1.0); first-line indent of 1.25 cm; justified alignment.

Abstract structure: first line – title of the paper; after one blank line – author information: surname, first name, academic degree, academic title or level of study; next line – full name of the higher education institution or organisation where the author works or studies; after one blank line – main text of the abstract; list of references – if applicable.

Figures must be created using graphics editors compatible with Microsoft Word and grouped as a single graphic object. Equations must be prepared using the built-in Microsoft Word equation editor or Microsoft Equation. Figures, tables and equations must comply with DSTU 3008:2015. Each figure must have a caption, and each table must have a title. If the text contains more than one figure or table, they must be numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals. Figures and tables must be placed after their first reference in the text and separated from the main text by one blank line. Tables must be presented in portrait page orientation only. Table titles and figure captions must be centred.

If necessary, a list of references containing no more than 5 entries may be provided at the end of the abstract. It must be formatted in Times New Roman, 12 pt. References must be listed in the order in which they are cited in the text and formatted in accordance with DSTU 8302:2015. In-text citations must be provided in square brackets, for example: [1, p. 55], [1; 2].

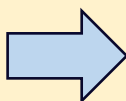

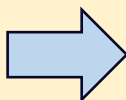
